Turn your Traditional quilt blocks into an original contemporary work of art.

This design is made up of 4 black on white fabrics and 4 white on black fabrics the center square fabric is red for both color ways. Please purchase the same amount of the following fabrics for **both** the light and dark color ways. The center square yardage includes for both color ways.

When adding the bias strip to the curve purchase 1 ½ yard of fabric.

Fabric Supply:

¼ yard for the center square

Fabric #1- ¾ yard

Fabric #2 -1 yard

Fabric #3 -1 ½ yards

Fabric #4 - 1 5/8 yard avoid fabrics with an obvious vertical or horizontal design

Sewing Supply:

Neutral Thread

Extra Needles

Rotary Cutter & Mat

12 ½" x 12 ½" square ruler

Pressing mat & Surface

Optional: Design wall

Pre –Class Instructions:

Please cut the same number of strips from **both** your light and dark fabrics for the project:

All strips are cut 2" wide by width of fabric.

Center square fabric cut 2 ½ strips

Fabric #1 Cut 11 strips

Fabric #2 Cut 15 strips

Fabric #3 Cut 24 strips

Fabric #4 Cut 27 strips
