### Table Runner 23 X 35

This is a great quick and easy project to help you on your way to learning the Blendable Curve technique. Please feel free to bring scraps to class to learn the technique and then if you like the process you can pick your final fabrics and make one for each friend and family member, or go crazy and make a full size quilt.

The Center Square Fabric is the same for "both" Color Ways (light and dark): **Cut 4 - 2" X 2" Squares**

Please note: The sample Peggy sent us is in various colors, not black and white. These directions were originally written for a black and white table runner like the black and white quilt. So, your dark fabric may be black, but it could be another dark color. Your light fabric may be white, or it could be another light color.



**So, for your black or dark fabric cut:**

#1 1 - 2" Strip the Width of Fabric

**PLEASE NOTE that we got some additional info from Peggy which is bold/underlined below:**

**This was in the original instruction list, but is NOT part of the table runner. Sorry for the confusion.** <sup>3/4</sup> yard red for red vein (this is the vein that runs between the light and dark sections of the "blendably" curved log cabin, and it does not have to be red – it needs to be a color that has high contrast with both your dark (or black) and light (or white) fabrics.

1 yard of background fabric – **Please NOTE: this is for the side and corner setting triangles**

1/4 yard for inner border

1/3 yard for binding

1 yard backing

### **The rest of your supplies:**

Sewing machine

Neutral Thread

Rotary Cutter

18 x 24" Mat

12 1/2" x 12 1/2" Square Ruler

Scissors

Small Trash Bag

4 – 6" x 6" Scrap Squares.

Pressing surface & Iron
